David Branch, Cuming County Economic Development Director, appeared before the Council and presented the Interlocal Agreement between Cuming County, the City of West Point, the City of Wisner, the Village of Beemer and the Village of Bancroft and the funding paid by each entity. He also gave an update on different projects in the County. The Interlocal Agreement proposes Cuming County pay 60%, City of West Point pay 15%, City of Wisner pay 10%, and the Village of Beemer and Village of Bancroft each pay 7.5% for the 2023-2024 year. Following review, it was moved by Smith and seconded by Stokely, to terminate the current Interlocal Agreement between Cuming County, the City of West Point, the City of Wisner, the Village of Beemer and the Village of Bancroft and approve the new Interlocal Agreement whereby the City of West Point will pay \$20,779.13 for Cuming County Economic Development. Voting Yea: Stokely, Penrose, Buse, Hugo, and Smith. Nay: None. Absent: Swenson. Motion carried.

The next agenda item was the use of Eminent Domain to acquire the property located at the W 1/2 of Lots 5 and 6 (House located at 130 E. Sheridan St.) and the South 4.44 feet of the West 65.33 feet of Lot 4 (containing 290.07 square feet, more or less), in Block 47, in the Original Plat of the City of West Point, Cuming County, Nebraska owned by Frat Order of Eagles. After discussion, it was moved by Stokely and seconded by Smith to set the terms of the purchase agreement as follows: (1) purchase price of \$150,000 with no increases, (2) a delayed closing with a cap of seven (7) years, and (3) 120 day notice after construction contract awarded. If the City has not started construction in that time this agreement will be terminated. Voting Yea: Stokely, Penrose, Buse, Hugo, and Smith. Nay: None. Absent: Swenson. Motion carried.

Drew Wimer, Vice President of West Point Rescue, advised the Council that Rescue has looked at bringing the billing back in house. For several years, the City has contracted with Quick Med Claims/EMS for their services. Under the Zoll Data Systems contract, Rescue personnel partnering with City employees would handle the billing. This would allow for more of the revenue to remain with the Rescue. The proposed contract is a 3-year contract with auto renewal. It was moved by Smith, seconded by Penrose, that the City accept the contract with Zoll Data Systems for a three-year term and that the Mayor be authorized to sign said contract. Voting Yea: Stokely, Penrose, Buse, Hugo, and Smith. Nay: None. Absent: Swenson. Motion carried.

Police Chief, John Adams, appeared before the Council to review the Interlocal Agreement for Law Enforcement Jurisdiction regarding the Cuming County Sheriff and the West Point Police Department. This agreement will be for a five year term and allow for joint law enforcement between the City of West Point and Cuming County and grant the City's police officers law enforcement powers on portions of streets and highways outside the City's territorial jurisdiction on the following road: (1) Highway 275 from Highway 32 South to County Road F; (2) Highway 32 from Highway 275 East to County Road 18; (3) County Road 18 from Highway 32 North to Washington Street; (4) Washington Street from Public School Road east to County Road 18; and (5) Highway 275 from Johnson Road North to Highway 9. It was moved by Stokely and seconded by Smith to approve the Interlocal Agreement for Law Enforcement Jurisdiction between Cuming County, Nebraska and the City of West Point, Nebraska and that the Mayor be authorized to sign said agreement. Voting Yea: Stokely, Penrose, Buse, Hugo, and Smith. Nay: None. Absent: Swenson. Motion carried.

The City Administrator then proceeded to report, on behalf of the Economic Development Committee, the following LB 840 Economic Development applications:

1. CC Thor Investments West Point LLC requesting \$45,000.00. Renovation and repair of the former Bohemian Duck building. The Committee recommended \$45,000.00 with a \$22,500.00 grant and a \$22,500.00 loan with a five-year term on box.

It was moved by Penrose and seconded by Buse to approve the recommendations of the Economic Development Committee for the above loan and grant from the LB 840 Economic Development Funds as presented. Voting Yea: Stokely, Penrose, Buse, Hugo and Smith. Nay: None. Absent: Swenson. Motion carried.

Moved by Smith, seconded by Penrose to approve the following application for a Special Designated Liquor Permit under the Nebraska Liquor Control Act:

(a) Feyerherm Enterprises LLC dba Roadhouse Lounge, for a Wedding Reception on September 9, 2023 at Nielsen Community Center from 5:00 PM to 12:00 PM.

Voting Yea: Stokely, Penrose, Buse, Hugo, and Smith. Nay: None. Absent: Swenson. Motion carried.

Moved by Buse, seconded by Smith, to approve the claim of Hugo Plumbing & Heating for services and supplies in the amount of \$14,510.04. Voting Yea: Stokely, Penrose, Buse and Smith.

Nay: None. Absent: Swenson. Abstain: Hugo. Motion carried.

Smith introduced the following resolution and moved its adoption:

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL of the City of West Point, Nebraska, to approve Application/Payment No. 10 in the amount of \$468,046.90 to Christiansen Construction Company for the West Point Aquatic Center Project and authorize the City Clerk to make payment.

Stokely seconded the motion. Voting Yea: Stokely, Penrose, Buse, Hugo and Smith. Nay: None.

Absent: Swenson. Motion carried and said resolution adopted.

Next Buse introduced the following resolution and moved its adoption:

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL of the City of West Point, Nebraska, to approve Change Orders 1 and 2 and Payment #2-Final in the amount of \$99,364.00 to Rutjens Construction Inc. for the relocation of utilities for the Hwy 275 Expressway project.

Stokely seconded the motion. Voting Yea: Stokely, Penrose, Buse, Hugo and Smith. Nay: None.

Absent: Swenson. Motion carried and said resolution adopted.

Moved by Penrose, seconded by Smith, to adjourn at 6:45 P.M. Voting Yea: Stokely, Penrose, Buse, Hugo and Smith. Nay: None. Absent: Swenson. Motion carried.
