NOTICE	E TO APPLICANT

If incorrect or inaccurate information is provided above, the application will be denied and you will be prevented from direct solicitation within the City for a period of one (1) year from the date of this application. All information provided by you will be verified by the City.

If the application is granted, the ordinances of the City prohibit you from any direct solicitation from the hours of 6:00pm to 8:00am. Any direct solicitation by you during the prohibited hours will result in the automatic revocation of your direct solicitation license and subject you to a fine as provided by city ordinances.

ARTICLE III - NONRESIDENT SALESMEN

SECTION 4-301: REGULATION

All non-resident individuals or businesses going door to door with the intent to sell any goods, service, product or insurance shall, before doing business within the City, make application for and be issued a license. This registration and licensing is to prevent the sale of fraudulent, dangerous and unhealthful goods and services, to protect the public by maintaining records of the products sold and the persons and companies responsible for such sales, to designate a place of trade if on public property and for the purpose of raising revenue. Application for a license shall be made to the city clerk upon blank forms supplied by the City, which shall contain all the necessary information and documents required for the protection of the residents of the City. Any person or persons granted a license shall be subject to any fees, occupation taxes and other rules and regulations which the City Council deems appropriate for the purposes stated herein. Any license so granted shall be subject to revocation in the event that the information provided is inaccurate or misleading.

SECTION 4-302: HOURS OF SOLICITATION

It shall be unlawful for any license holder to solicit any individual house to house between the hours of 6:00 P.M. and 8:00 A.M., unless he/she has a previous appointment with the resident of the premises solicited. It shall be unlawful at any hour for any person to solicit without having a proper license on his/her person at all times. "

SECTION 4-303: EXCEPTIONS

Nothing herein shall be construed to apply to any person selling produce raised within the county, to wholesale salespeople soliciting merchants directly or to residential route salespersons. This article shall also not pertain to nor apply to persons canvassing residents within the City for religious, political or other non-commercial purposes. ^a
