MINUTES OF MEETING

A special meeting of the Mayor and City Council of the City of West Point, Nebraska was convened in open and public session at 4:30 P.M. on Wednesday, July 27, 2022 in the Council Chambers at the Municipal Building, 444 S. Main Street, West Point, Nebraska.
